## Introducing PERFORMER

The PERFORMER project aims to contribute in (i) drastically reducing the gap between expected and actual building energy performance, and (ii) promoting the energy performance guarantee approach.

In this perspective, PERFORMER will deliver a comprehensive energy performance assessment framework, including a set of methodologies along with a suite of adapted and integrated off-the-shelf tools (e.g. energy simulation software) that factor in building intrinsic attributes, as well as indoor and outdoor environment parameters.

PERFORMER will address the needs of stakeholders across the energy value chain (builders, contracting owners, occupants and ESCOs), embedded in a dedicated quality process ensuring the strict adherence to targeted actual energy performance.
